## SmartBall Inspection

Pure Technologies performed a SmartBall inspection of Bound Brook pump station's 10 inch force main. The SmartBall inspection is done by inserting the "SmartBall" into a launch point at the beginning of the line, pumping it to a retrieval site at the end of the line and analyzing data collected by sensors in the center of the ball. The SmartBall itself is a foam ball, sized specifically for the line to be inspected, with a set of sensors imbedded in the center.

MCUA Maintenance, Lines and Meters, and the operator of Bound Brooks sewer system, NJ American Water, also assisted Pure with the inspection. Pure has inspected the South Bay Force Main for MCUA previously and the information gathered from the tests have been of great help in condition assessment and pinpointing locations of taps.

The BBFM was originally installed in 1957 and is approximately 3,300 feet long.
