NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD A CONTRACT UNDER A NATIONAL
COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT TO
VERIZON WIRELESS

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Middlesex County Utilities Authority (the “Authority”) intends to award the following contract through a national cooperative contract for a period of one year, at its January 2021 Regular Board meeting for the procurement of iPhones with iPhone Verizon Service. It is the intent of the Authority to make a contract award to Verizon Wireless pursuant to the proposal submitted in response to the Authority’s Request for Bids. The Authority is a member of the U. S. Communities National Cooperative Purchasing Program, and is permitted to join national cooperative purchasing agreements under the authority of N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2(b)3.

The contract award is “not to exceed” \$17,500.00.

The Authority believes that Verizon Wireless will meet the Authority’s need for the procurement of iPhones with iPhone Verizon Service and that it is more cost effective for the Authority to purchase said services from Verizon Wireless through the national cooperative contract.
